





Grafton-Midview Public Library Endowment Fund

Investing in the community by securing the future of the Library!

The Library Endowment fund helps secure a place for continuing educational growth, enlightenment of the arts and sciences, and entertainment in various formats for all ages in the Midview district.

Our service area covers the Midview school district with a population of 23,000. The Library provides early child literacy story times for children as young as six months to pre-school age, and programs such as 1,000 Books before Kindergarten.

Our youth services collection includes magazines, Launchpads, early literacy kits, movies and audio books, along with a large collection of books.

We offer programming for tweens and have a Teen Zone area for our 13-18 year olds.

Our collection of adult materials includes inspirational books, non-fiction and fiction in regular and large print, audio books, movies, magazines, plus various electronic databases and digital books for reading and listening.

Our adult services offer Tech Tutor instruction, a large array of programming all year long for adults, and services such as passport, notary, AARP tax service, and book clubs. We have board games, ukuleles, blood pressure equipment, and hotspots for checkout. We connect with our past in the Doris Wildenheim Local History room and Biblioboard, for Our digital database of local Grafton history.

The Library recently added outdoor lockers in the front of the Library building for our patrons to access material 24/7.

Funds from the GMPL Endowment Fund went towards this purchase.
